As an example, if you take a US size 8D in Allen Edmonds shoes, then the size 7.5E in Crockett & Jones should fit you well, or the size 7.5F in Loake footwear.

If in doubt of your size, may we suggest that you measure your feet using the following method :

Please stand with your heels against a hard surface and measure from the heel to the tip of the big toe.

For the circumference, please measure around the widest part of the foot which is at the big toe joint. If these measurements could be forwarded to us, this should help us suggest the most suitable width.

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General points to consider :

An Oxford style shoe allows less room for adjustment due to the closed stitching of the quarters.

A Derby style allows more flexibility in terms of width requirement as the quarters are open and the lacing allows for a higher foot.

A Loafer style will slacken more over time and consequently they tend to be manufactured slightly narrower than a laced style.

The difference in length is approx 4mm per UK half size.

As shoes increase in size, the length and the width both increase such that a size 9F shoe is one size bigger and once size wider than a size 8F. The size 8G is one size wider than the size 8F and would roughly correspond in width to a size 9F.

e.g. sizes 10E, 9F, 8G and 7H would all be approximately the same width.

Please note that due to the vagaries of different shapes of lasts and feet, it is still difficult to be absolutely certain whether a particular style will suit you without trying on the shoes.
